

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
Nat 8-16p (5)+ cards, system usually on after 1♣/♦/♥ by opponents.
System on after partners major overcalls (transfers)
Cue bid in opener suit (minors) shows good raise in partners overcall. New suit is forcing 1 round.
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
Direct: 15-18 bal, other 2 suits if both opponents bids on 1.st level, 11-14 4 th hand.
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
2 diamonds=weak, Unusual 2NT,
2h and 2 sp=intermediate 11-15p system on,
Reopen: weak
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
Michaels cue bids
3m over 1minor opening= natural, pre-empt
3M over 1M= asks for stopper
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
Dbl=♣, short ♣ or majors with better hearts. (13p+ against mini NT)
2♣=♦, or majors with better spades, or diamonds and clubs
2♦/♥/♠ transfers, 3♣/♦ pre-emptive, 2NT majors strong, or minors weak or strong. In 4 th 2♣ majors/2♦ 1 major /2♥/♠ weak major
VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
Takeout doubles, splinters
Cuebid=Good raise in partners suit/transfers on majors.
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
Double = black or reds, 1♦ majors or minors, Int=♣ and ♥ or ♠ and ♦. 2NT or 3NT=any 2 suits, more shape. Other bids are natural undefined.
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
Weak jumps, redouble= 10+
Transfers= after 1M openings. Double-capaletti

Strong club system
1♦= 11-15 unbalanced (0+ diamonds) or 15-17 bal.
1♥/♠ can be weak (9-15hcp) usually 5 cards in the opening suit
12-14 NT.
Multi, 2♠=normal opening range 5+5+ in minors
UDCA
SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE
Transfers after major openings
2♣ Minors 11-15, 5+5+
2♦ Multi 26+ bal or weak major
2NT majors or minors 5+5+ 5-10hcp
SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES
